Time to Move Forward with New State Partial-Birth Abortion Ban

"We are thankful to Attorney General Van Hollen for conducting such a careful review of Wisconsin's law banning the partial-birth abortion procedure," said Susan Armacost, Legislative Director. "Now that he has confirmed that the Wisconsin law is not constitutionally compatible with the federal partial-birth abortion ban, it is time to move forward with a new state ban on the gruesome, late-term abortion procedure."

"Prosecution of partial-birth abortion cases are best handled at the state and local level. It is important that prosecutors have the tools they need to ensure that the ban on partial-birth abortions is expeditiously enforced."
