Tremendous Victory for Unborn Children as U. S. Supreme Court Upholds Federal Ban on Partial-Birth Abortion

For immediate release: Wednesday, April 18, 2007

"At long last, unborn children in the United States will be protected from the gruesome late-term partial-birth abortion procedure," stated Barbara Lyons, Executive Director for Wisconsin Right to Life.

"It is hard to imagine that our nation had to work for 15 years to outlaw this procedure." said Lyons.

In a partial-birth abortion procedure, a baby at 20 weeks or later in pregnancy is pulled feet first from the mother's womb until only the head remains inside the mother. The abortionist then stabs the baby at the base of the skull and inserts a device which suctions out the baby's brains.

"The federal partial-birth abortion ban will be in effect in all states, including Wisconsin," said Lyons.
